Emphasis is placed on real-time application, self-awareness, and the use of structured coaching approaches to unlock potential. By the end of the course, participants will have gained the confidence, competence, and strategies to lead with clarity, empathy, and effectiveness through coaching.

- Supporting career planning and long-term growth conversations
- Encouraging ownership, self-direction, and accountability

- Facilitating team discussions using coaching techniques
