AI3-3 AI-Enhanced Critical Thinking and Decision Making

Artificial intelligence is transforming how organisations analyse information, solve problems and make decisions. While AI can provide powerful insights, recommendations and forecasts, effective decision-making still depends on critical thinking, professional judgement and the ability to evaluate information objectively. This practical three-day programme develops participants' ability to think critically, solve complex problems and make informed decisions in an AI-enabled workplace. Participants will learn how to combine structured decision-making techniques with AI tools, evaluate AI-generated insights, challenge assumptions, recognise bias and apply sound judgement when working alongside increasingly sophisticated AI systems.

Critical Thinking in an AI-Enabled Workplace

- Understanding critical thinking and decision-making in the age of AI

- Recognising bias, inaccuracies and limitations in AI-generated outputs

- Applying structured questioning and reasoning techniques to challenge both human and AI assumptions
- Understanding when AI strengthens decision quality and when caution is required

AI-Enhanced Problem Solving

- Applying structured problem-solving frameworks, including root cause analysis, 5 Whys, SWOT analysis and decision trees
- Using AI to support research, analysis and information gathering
- Leveraging AI tools to generate options, identify patterns and explore alternative perspectives
- Comparing human-generated and AI-generated solutions to workplace challenges
- Using AI to challenge assumptions and uncover blind spots in decision-making
- Assessing the quality and practicality of AI-supported solutions
- Practical exercises using AI tools to solve complex workplace problems

Decision Making and Judgement with AI

- Making decisions under uncertainty, complexity and risk
- Using AI to support forecasting, scenario planning and risk assessment
- Interpreting and validating AI-generated recommendations and insights
- Recognising hallucinations, overconfidence and limitations in AI outputs
- Combining AI-generated insights with professional expertise, organisational priorities and stakeholder considerations
- Understanding accountability, governance and ethical responsibilities when using AI-assisted decision-making
- Exploring the growing role of agentic AI and human oversight in decision-making processes
- Developing a personal action plan for applying AI-enhanced critical thinking and decision-making in the workplace

Competencies

At the end of this course, delegates will be able to:

- Apply structured frameworks for critical thinking, decision-making and problem-solving
- Evaluate information, evidence and AI-generated insights with confidence and objectivity

- Identify cognitive biases in both human reasoning and AI-generated outputs
- Use AI tools to support analysis, problem-solving and decision-making activities
- Assess risks, opportunities and alternative courses of action using AI-assisted approaches
- Combine AI-generated recommendations with professional judgement and organisational context
- Develop a practical action plan for applying AI-enhanced critical thinking and decision-making in their role
